Use this site to **pre-register for your voluntary COVID-19 vaccination free of charge in the Austrian Province of Salzburg**. When your pre-registration has been completed you can choose your preferred vaccination centre (*Impfstraße*).

PLEASE NOTE: Until the end of June at the latest, pre-registration for COVID-19 vaccination is only possible for vaccination centres (*Impfstraße*). From July at the latest, online pre-registration will again be possible with general practitioners and doctor's surgeries that provide vaccinations.

You will receive further information promptly by e-mail or text message.

Please note:

You need a mobile phone that can receive text messages and an Austrian social security number to pre-register online.

If you have pre-registered for a COVID-19 vaccination and received a TAN code, please use this site to **book an appointment for your COVID-19 vaccination** based on the prioritisation by the National Vaccination Panel.

Use the TAN code to book an appointment either with a doctor's surgery that provides vaccinations or with a vaccination centre (*Impfstraße*) in the Province of Salzburg.

Booking is only possible for people who have pre-registered for a COVID-19 vaccination and received an e-mail or text message inviting them to make an appointment for vaccination. Depending on your choice of communication channel, you will receive the invitation to make an appointment either by e-mail or by Short Message Service. If you have not provided digital contact details, your vaccination centre (*Impfstraße*)/vaccinating doctor's practice will call you to make the appointment.

You can only book your vaccination appointment yourself using the TAN code you will receive by e-mail or text message. This TAN code will be actively sent to you.

At the end of the registration process, you will receive an information and consent form that we ask you to fill in, print out and bring with you to your vaccination appointment.

If you belong to either a high-risk or a risk group, you will receive an additional form. Please have this form confirmed by your treating doctor and bring a print-out of the form with you to your vaccination appointment.
