



# COVID-19 vaccination: Key information

Getting vaccinated is the best way to fight the COVID-19 pandemic. It reduces your risk of getting seriously ill from COVID-19 as well as the risk of passing the virus on to others. The Province of Salzburg hopes to encourage as many people as possible to get vaccinated. Every jab counts. Please see some key information below.

## Vaccination certificate

How to prove your vaccination status:

- A vaccination card issued when you get your jab, or your vaccination pass
- Your digital COVID-19 certificate, accessed by means of your mobile phone signature (*Handy-Signatur*) or citizen card (*Bürgerkarte*). Printouts can be obtained from doctors, chemists, many local or district authorities, or from the Österreichische Gesundheitskasse (Federal Health Insurance Company).

## Vaccine side effects

The vaccines used in Austria and the EU have met strict standards and are very safe. Even so, you may have certain temporary side effects for several days after a COVID-19 jab, including aches, redness or swelling around the injection site, as well as fever, a headache, or pain in the limbs. Serious side effects are very rare. If your side effects have not subsided after a few days, please consult a physician.
