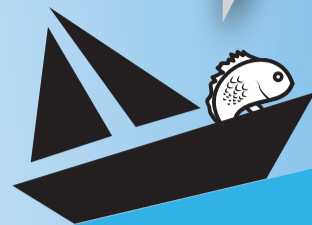

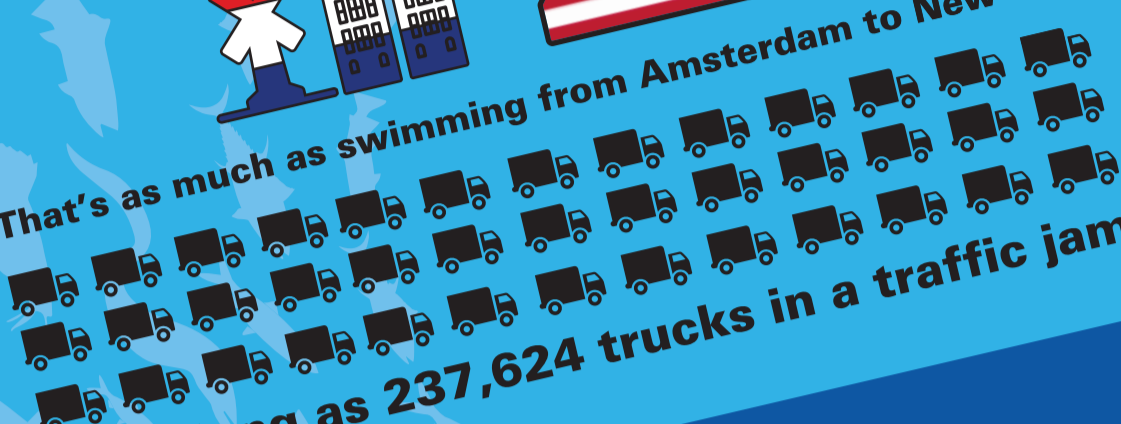
Fish migration is the journey that fish make to reproduce or feed

That's as much as swimming from Amsterdam to New York

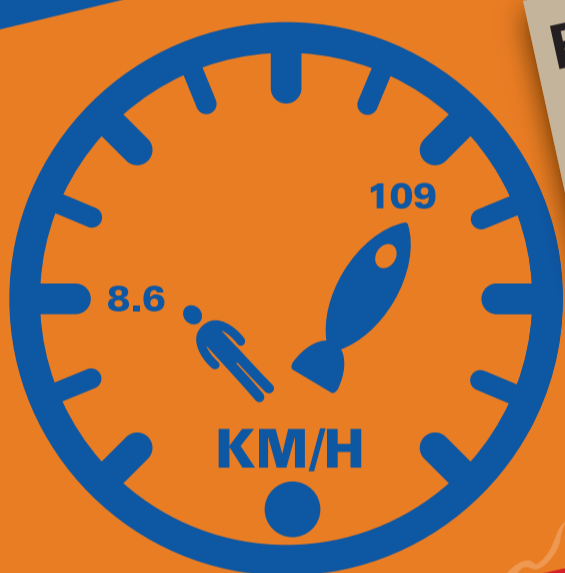


Or as long as 237,624 trucks in a traffic jam

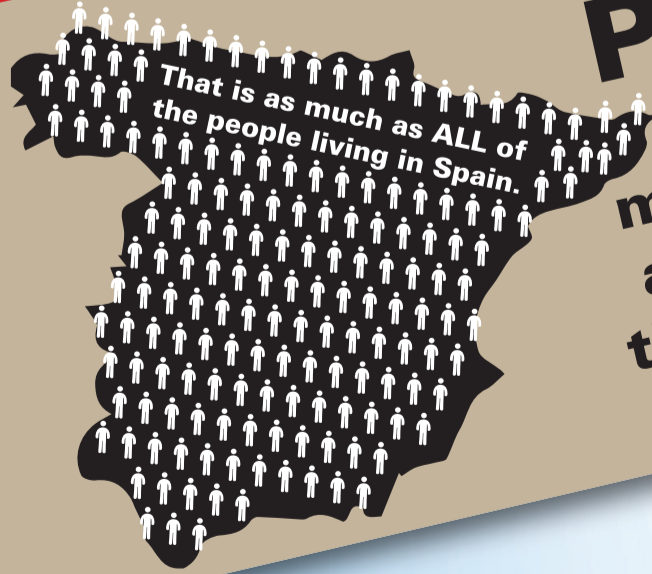
Unfortunately, fish can't travel like we can. They encounter barriers such as dams.
